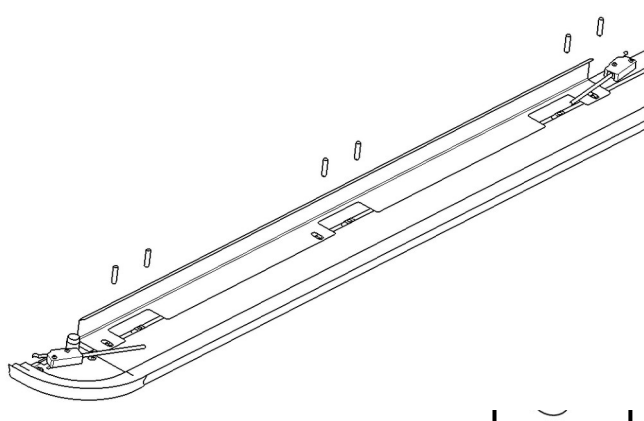
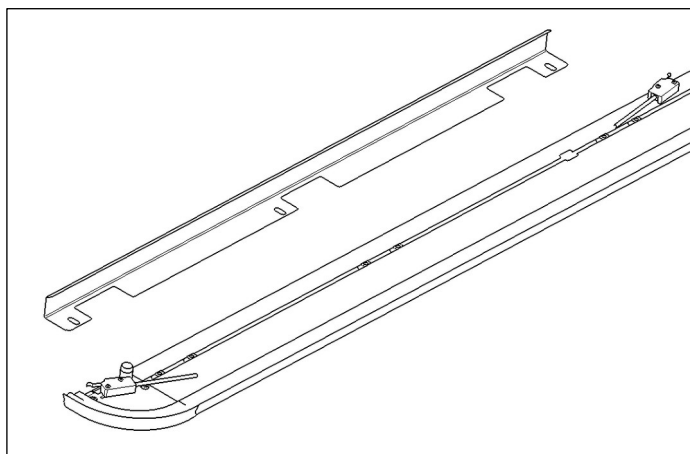
SIDE RAIL INSTALLATION



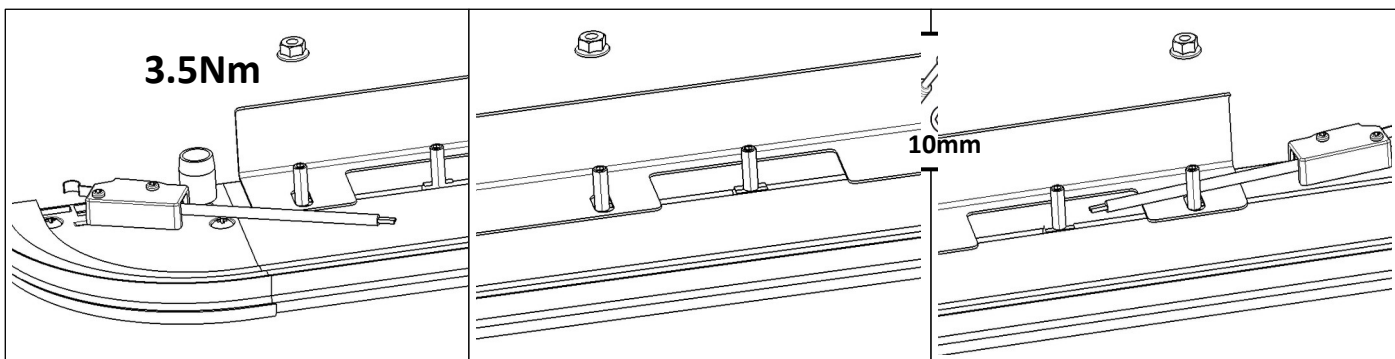
Slide the T-Nuts into side rails, 6 pieces on each side.



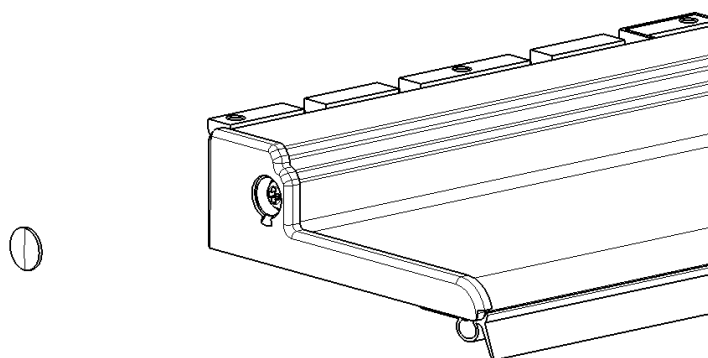
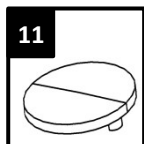
Slide the T-Nuts to appropriate position, as above picture shows. Two of them will be slid towards the front side.



Install the wire harness board; adjust the T-Nuts to appropriate position. Then put on the M6× 25 Inner Hex thread rod.

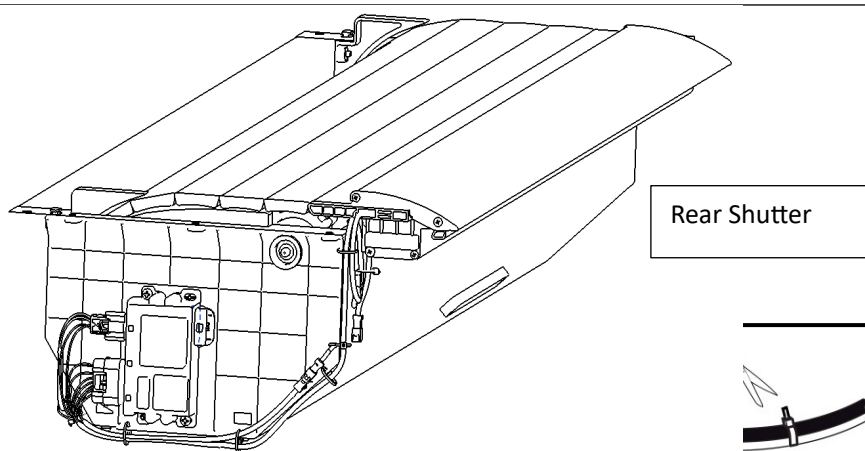


Fasten the wire harness board with 3 pieces flange nuts.

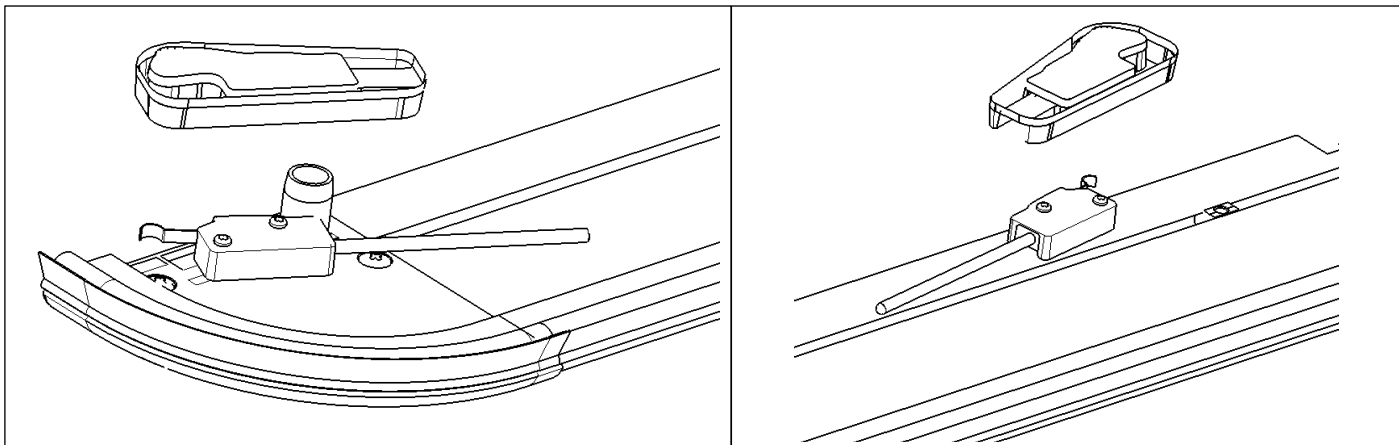


Put the plastic end cap on the front side of the side rail. Assembly way is same on both sides.

SIDE RAIL & CANISTER

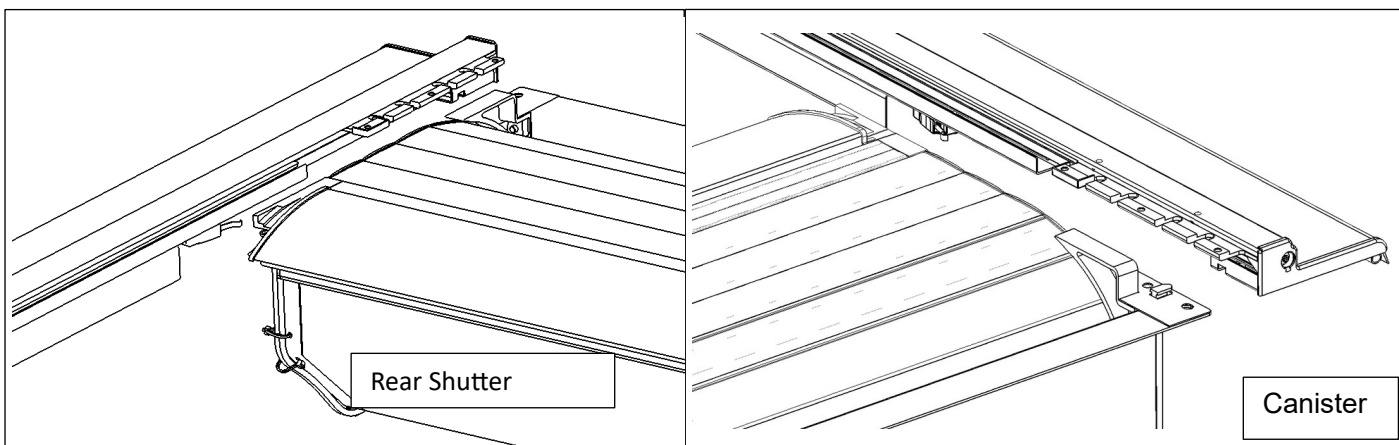


Pull out the shutters a little bit, release the cable tie for switch.



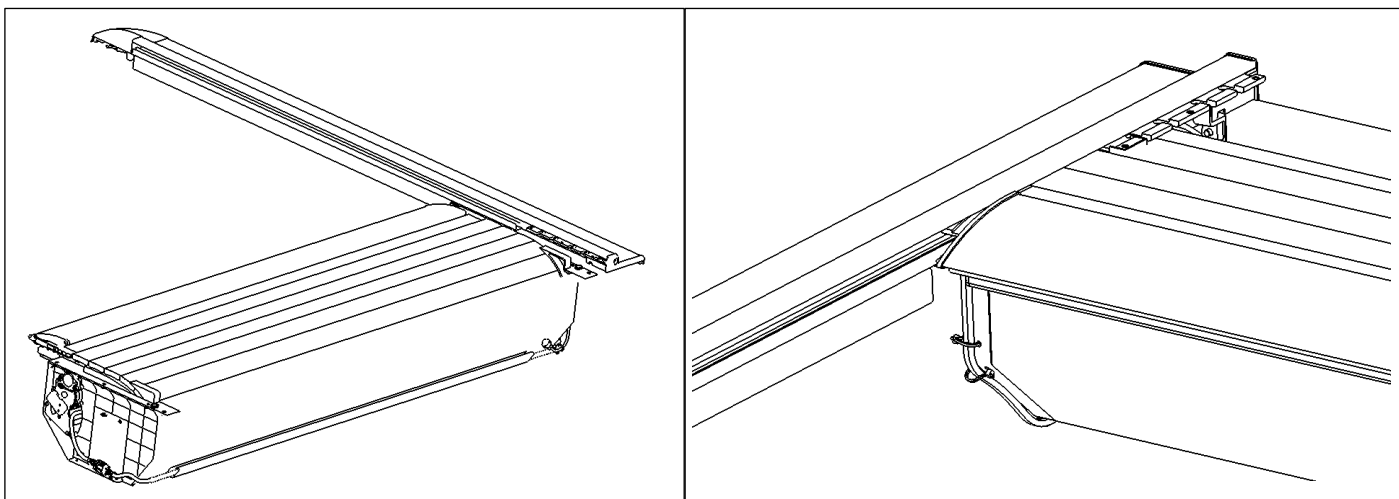
Loosen the tap screw a little bit, and then remove the blister packing on the switch.

Notice: Loosen the screw a little is enough, do not take them out.



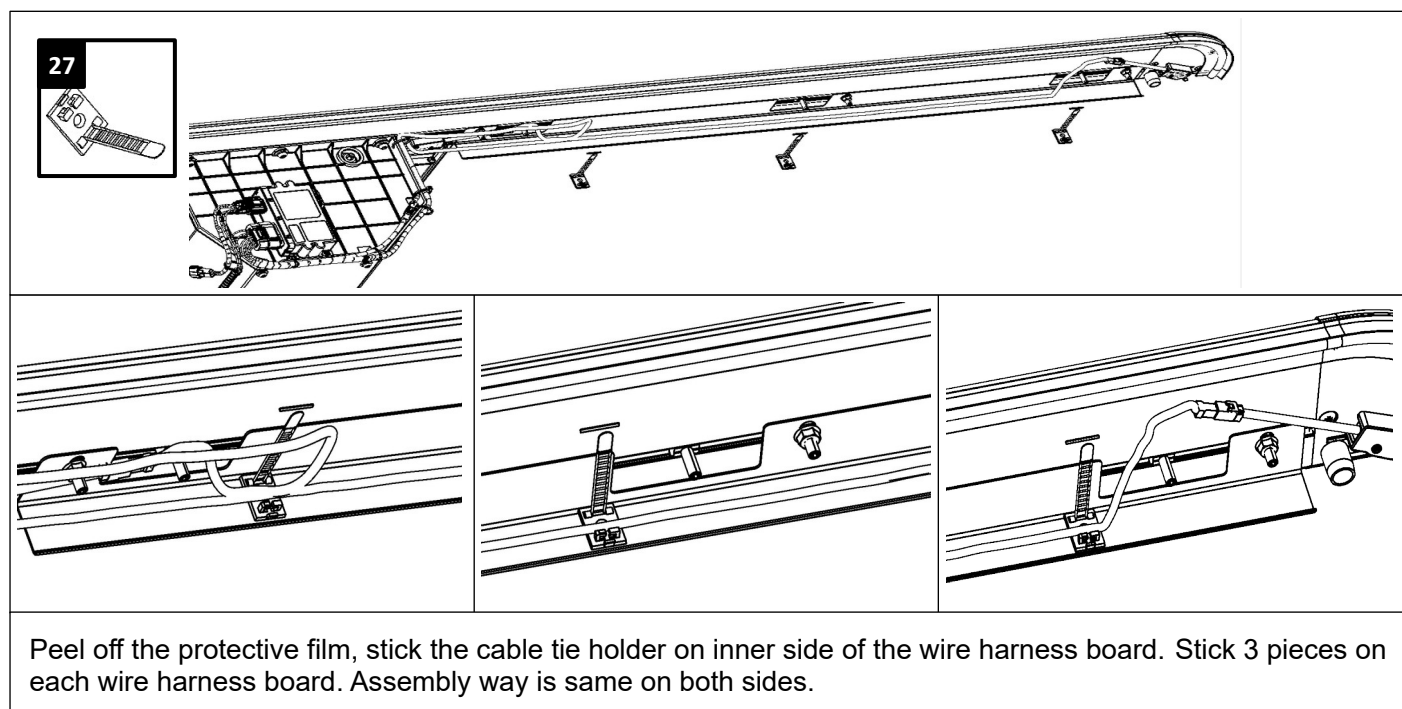
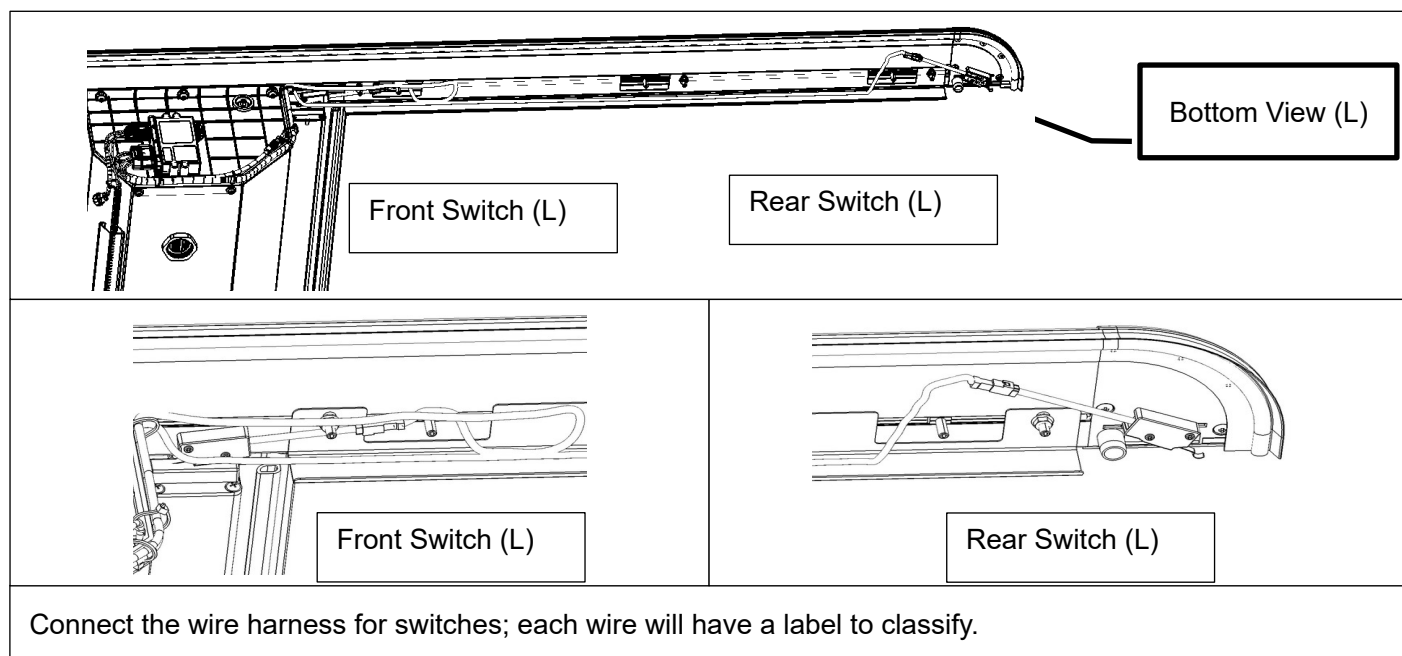
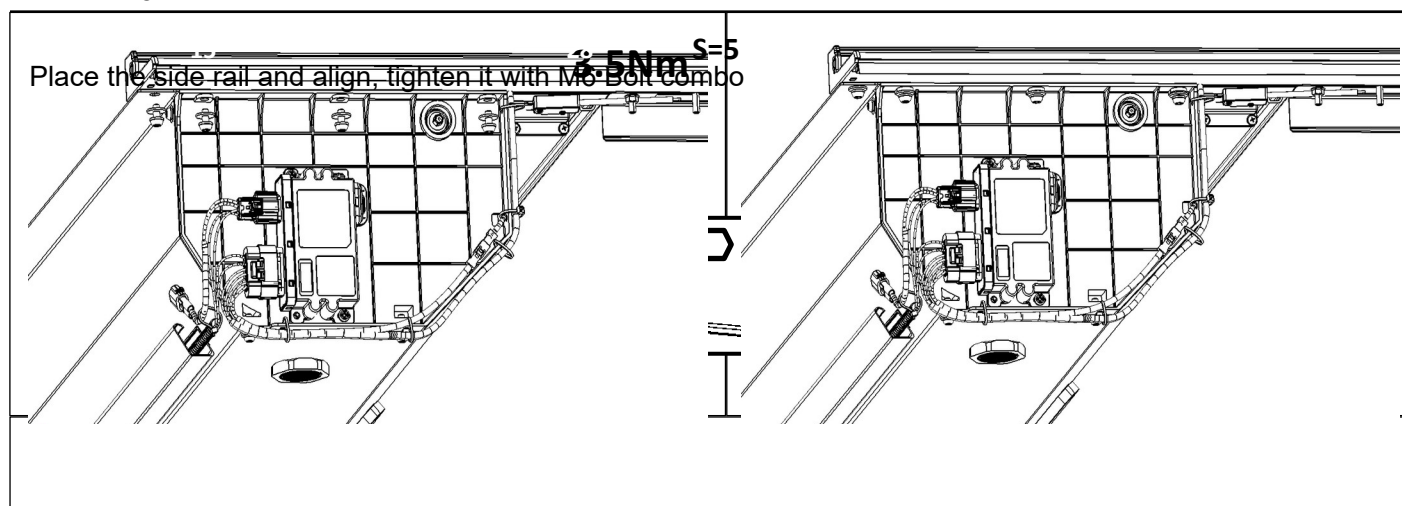
Place the side rail on and align.

Notice: Be careful, the switch may get damaged if it hit the canister harshly.

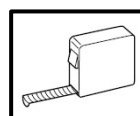
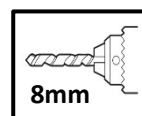
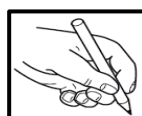
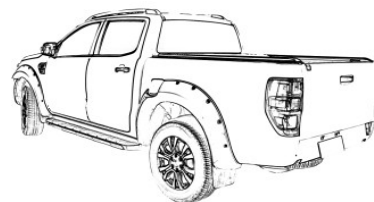
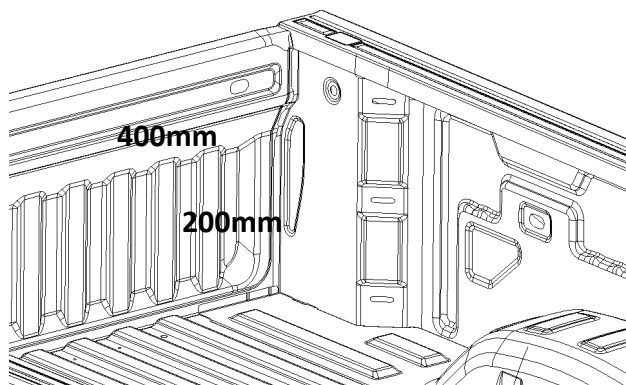


Install the side rail, align to the canister.

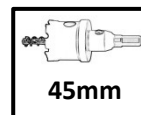
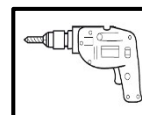
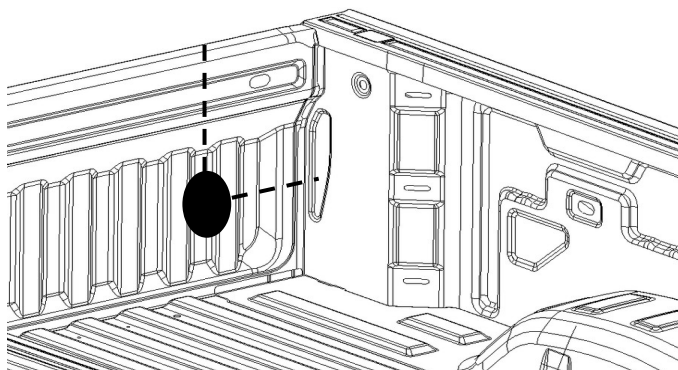


Drilling Holes for Drainage Tube

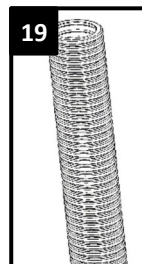
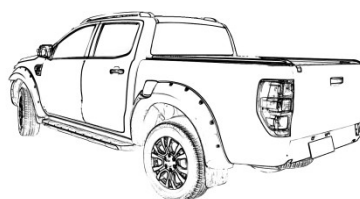
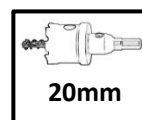
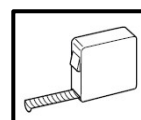
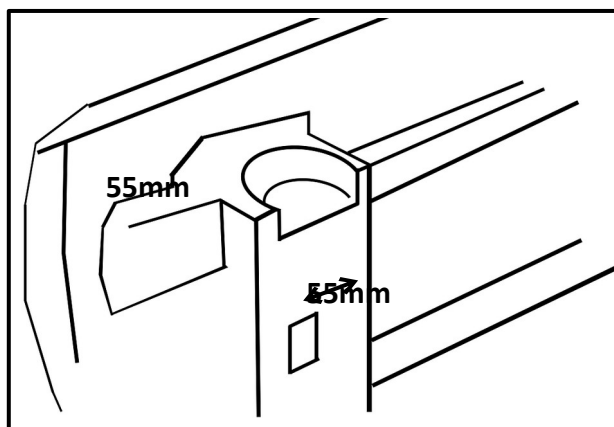


Measure and mark up the positions for the front drain tubes on both sides. Then drill through the truck bed with 8mm drill. **Notice:** Positions for drain tubes may be different for some pickup trucks.

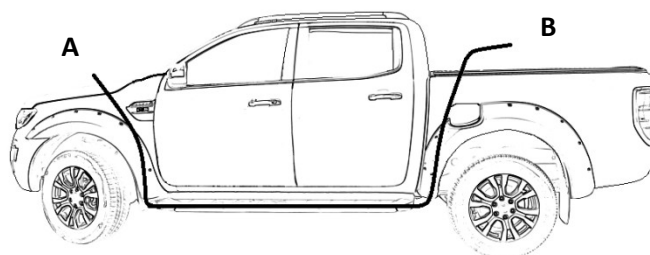
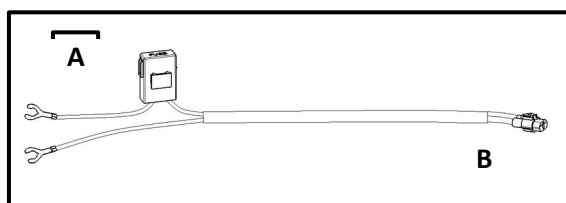
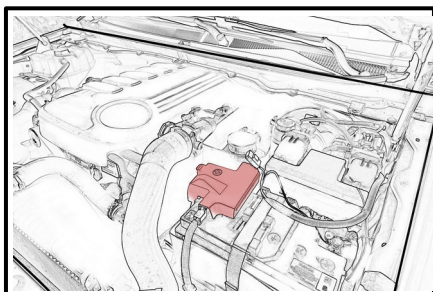


Drill out the front pilot holes in the truck bed with 45mm holesaw. To avoid getting rust, you should paint the drain hole on truck bed before putting on the grommet.

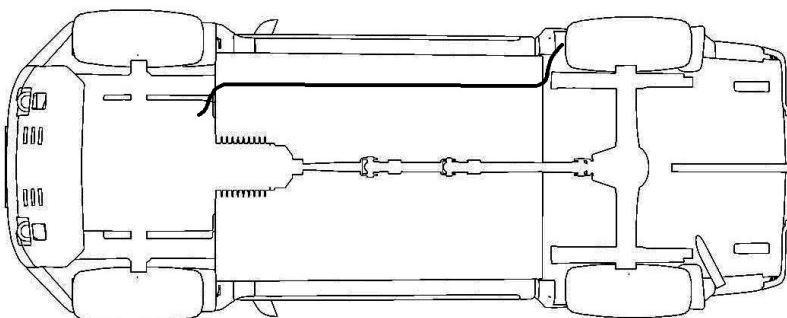
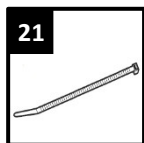


Measure and mark up the positions for the rear drain tubes on both sides. Drill the locations with 20mm holesaw. **Notice:** Just for reference, for some vehicles the rear drain hole positions would be different.

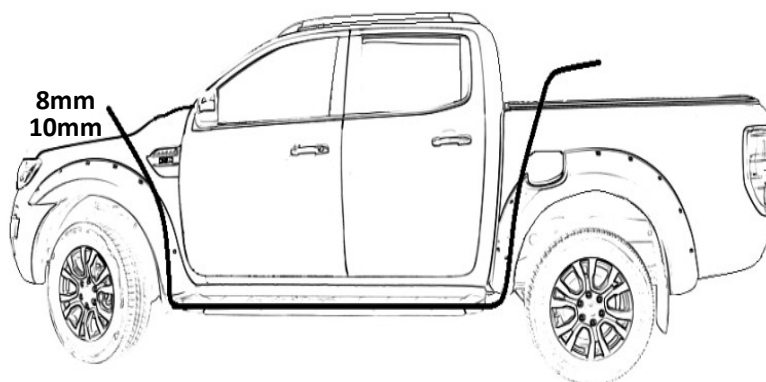
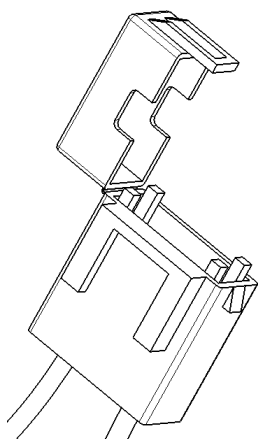
Route the Wiring Harness



Starting from the chassis rail in front of the LHS rear wheel, feed the wire harness to vehicle battery through chassis.



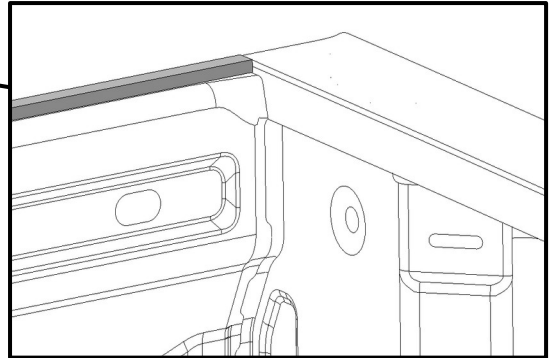
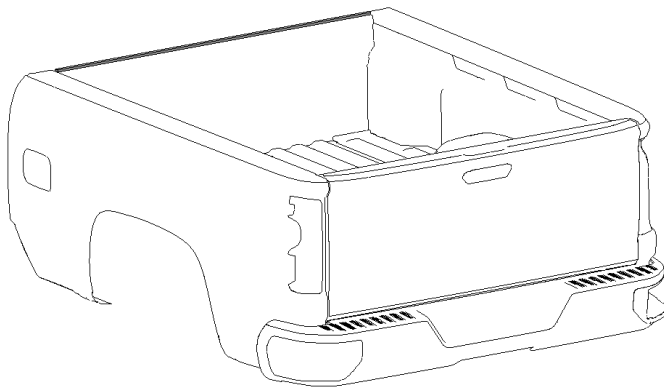
Attach the wiring harness to the chassis rail using hole in the tab mount, use cable tie.



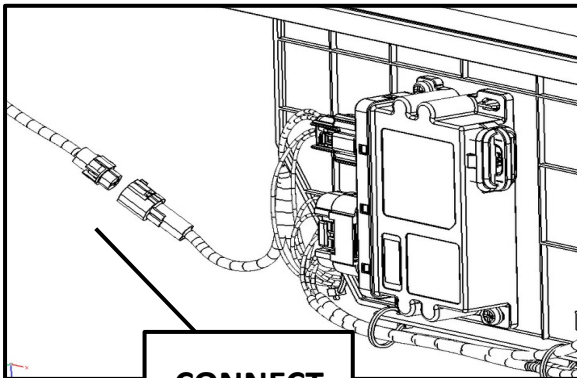
Remove the fuse from fuse holder. Connect the vehicle harness to the positive and negative terminals of the battery. **NOTE: Black- Negative; Red- Positive. Fit fuse to the fuse holder on the harness.**

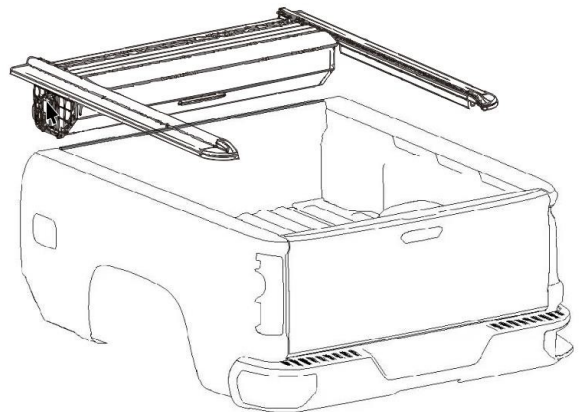

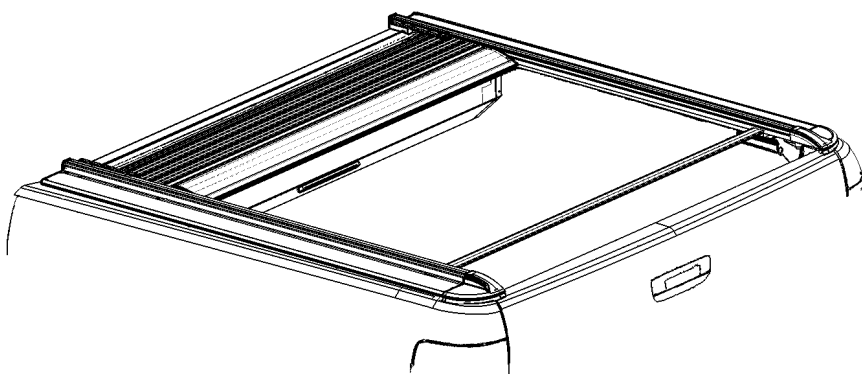
Install the front foam tape on the top of the bulkhead.



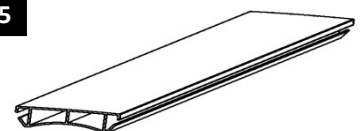

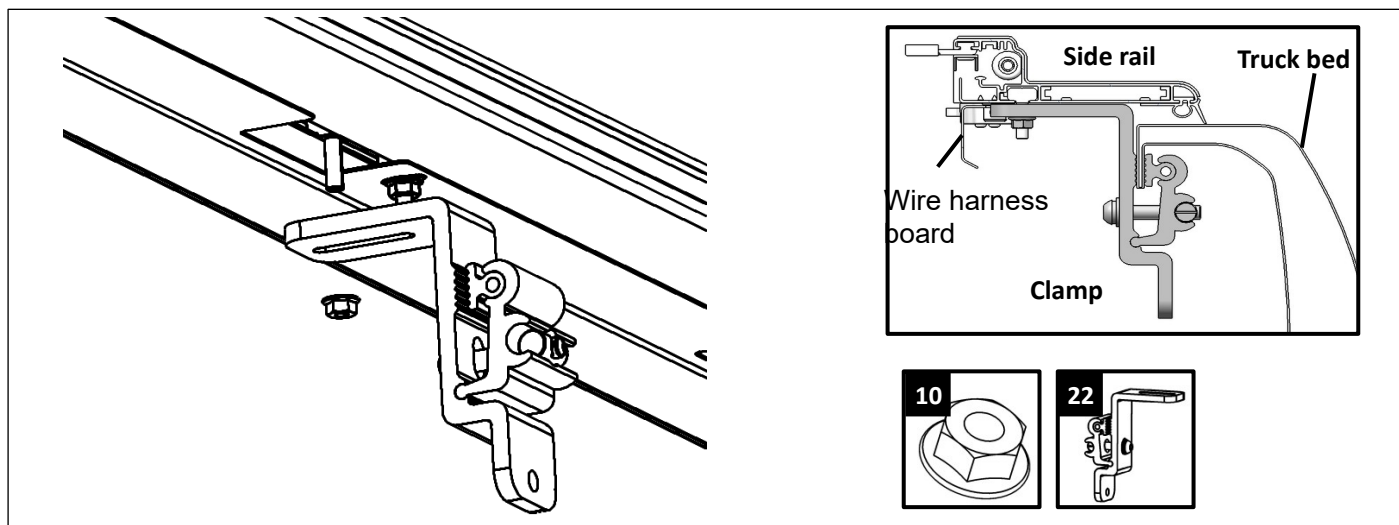
Put the roller shutter on truck bed, and then connect the wire harness.



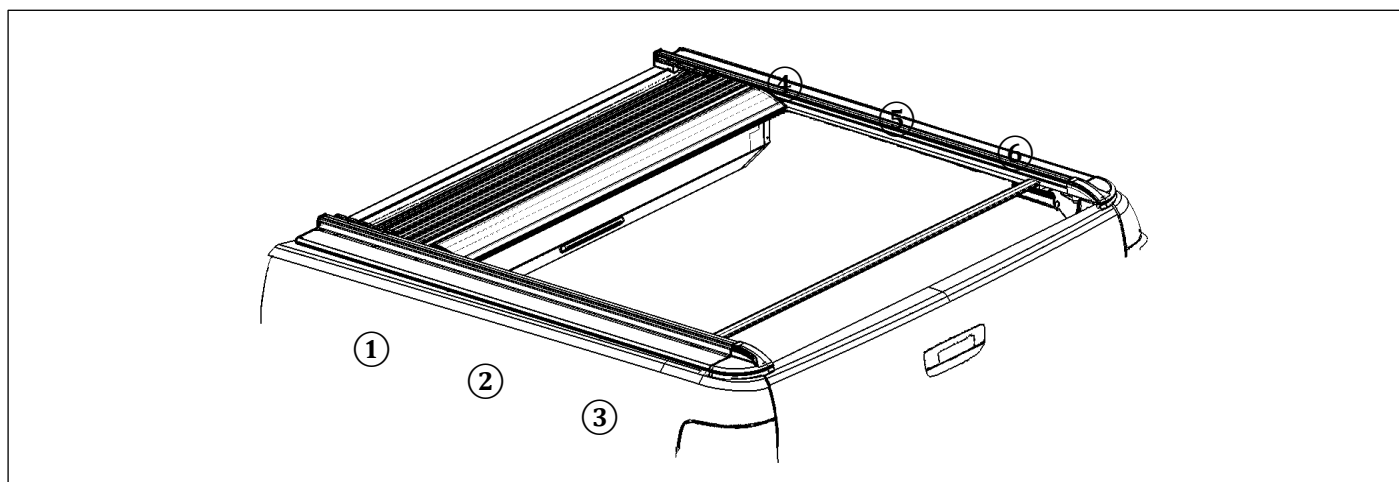
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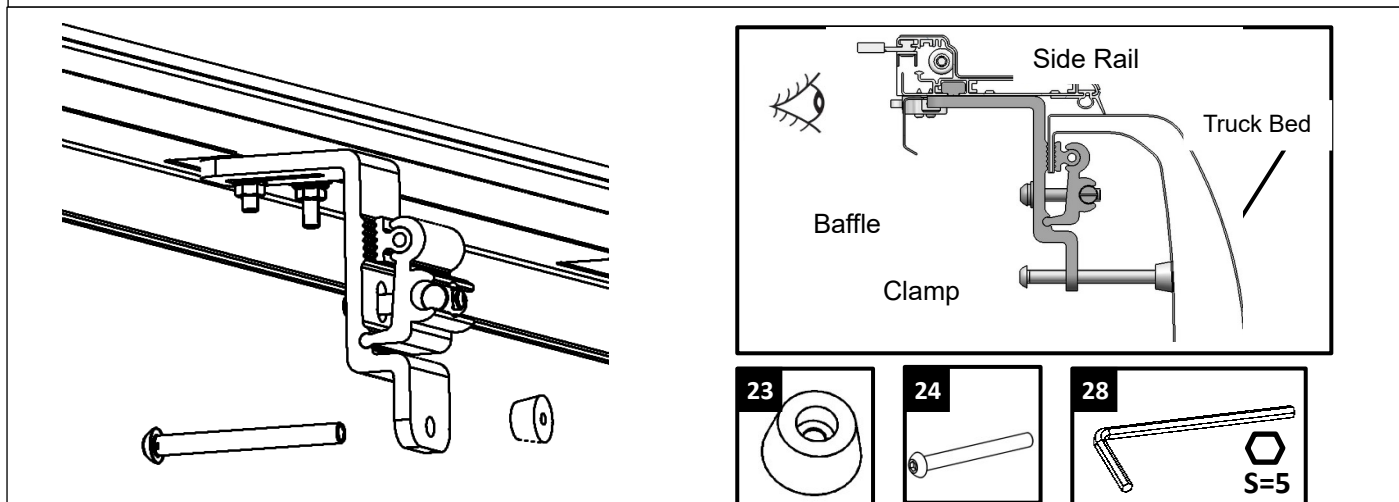
Put on the Aluminum standard bar, to keep the side rails on parallel status.



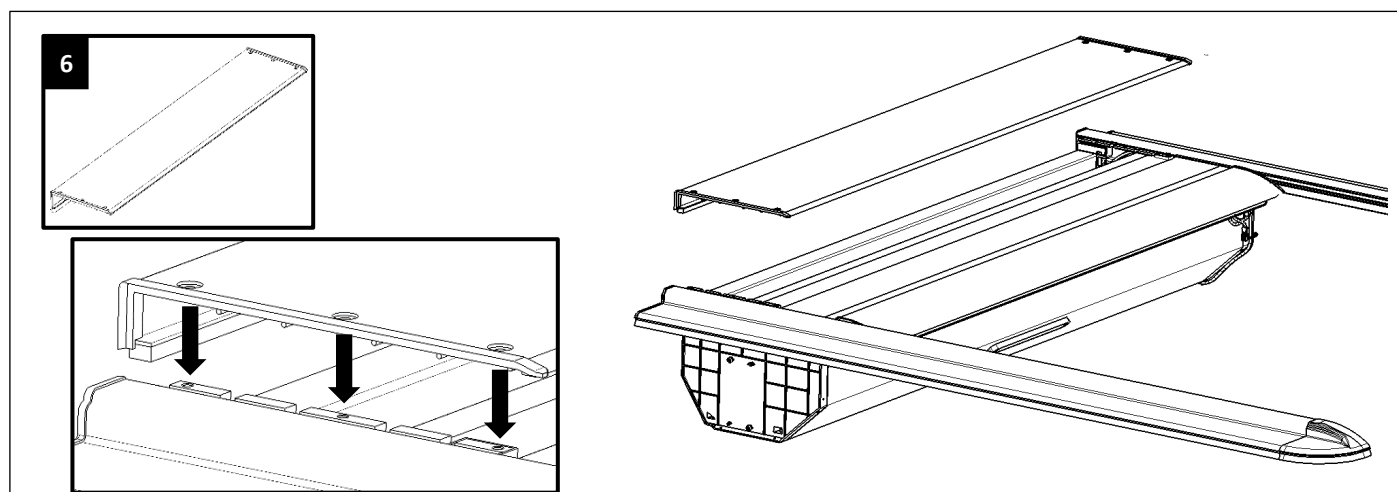
Install the clamps to fasten the roller shutter on truck bed.



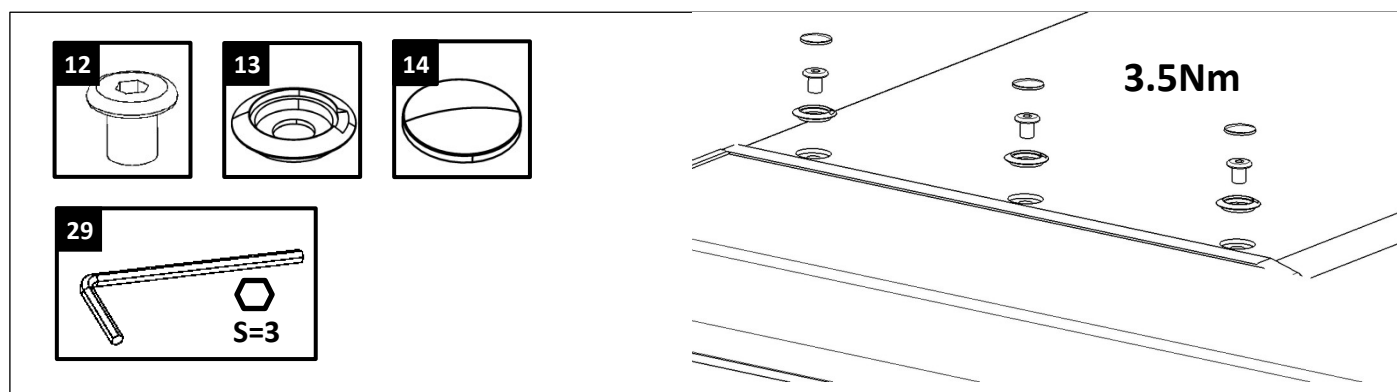
Install the clamps according slot part of the wire harness board. Fasten the M8 x 4 bolts to adjust the side rails on horizontal status. (Clamp ①、③、④、⑥)



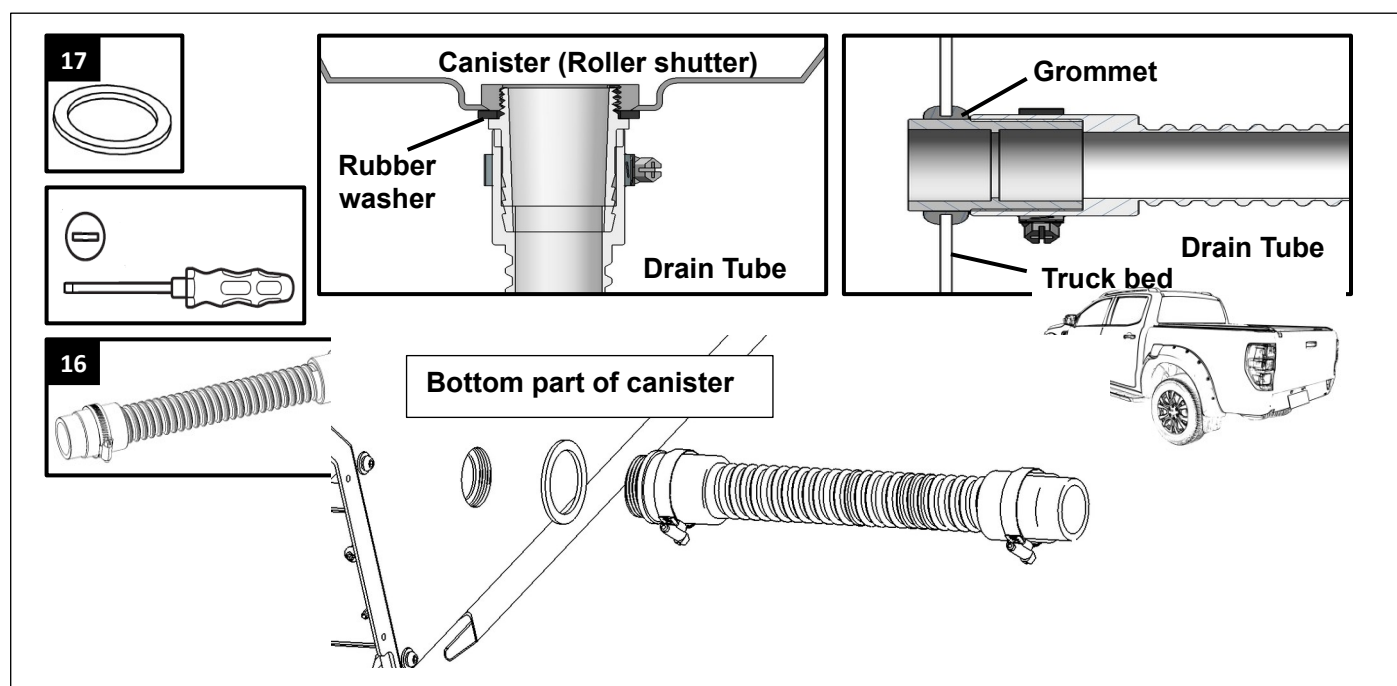
To adjust the side rail on horizontal status, you can fasten the M8 x 4 bolt on the clamp. (As above picture shows)



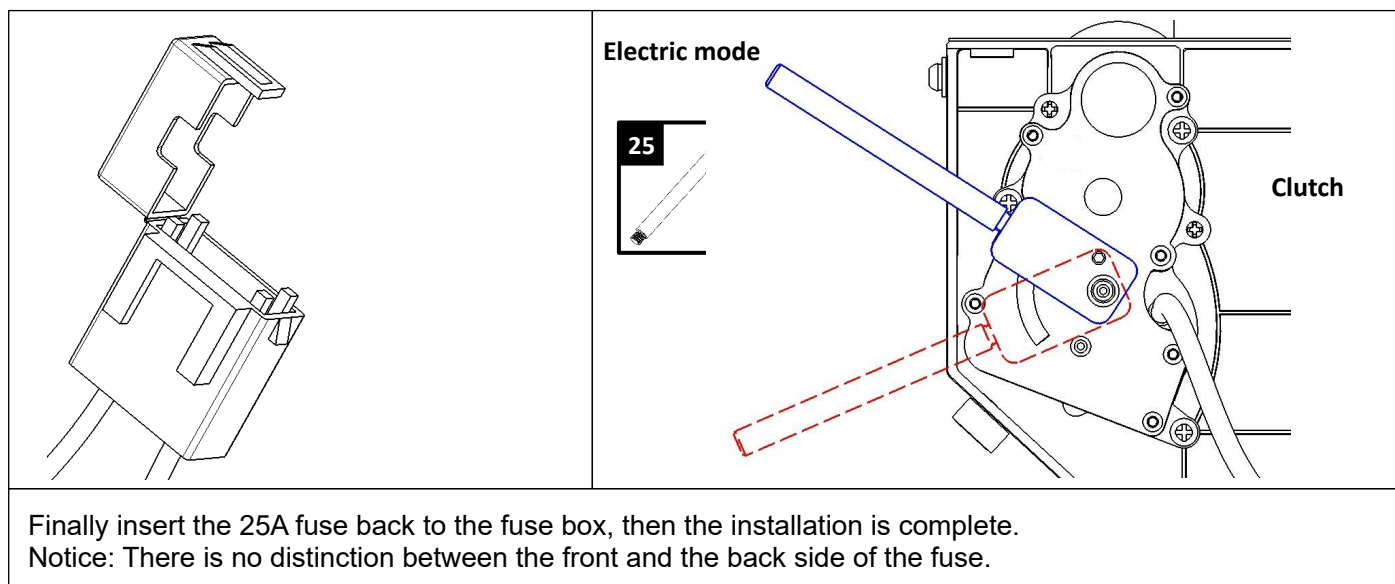
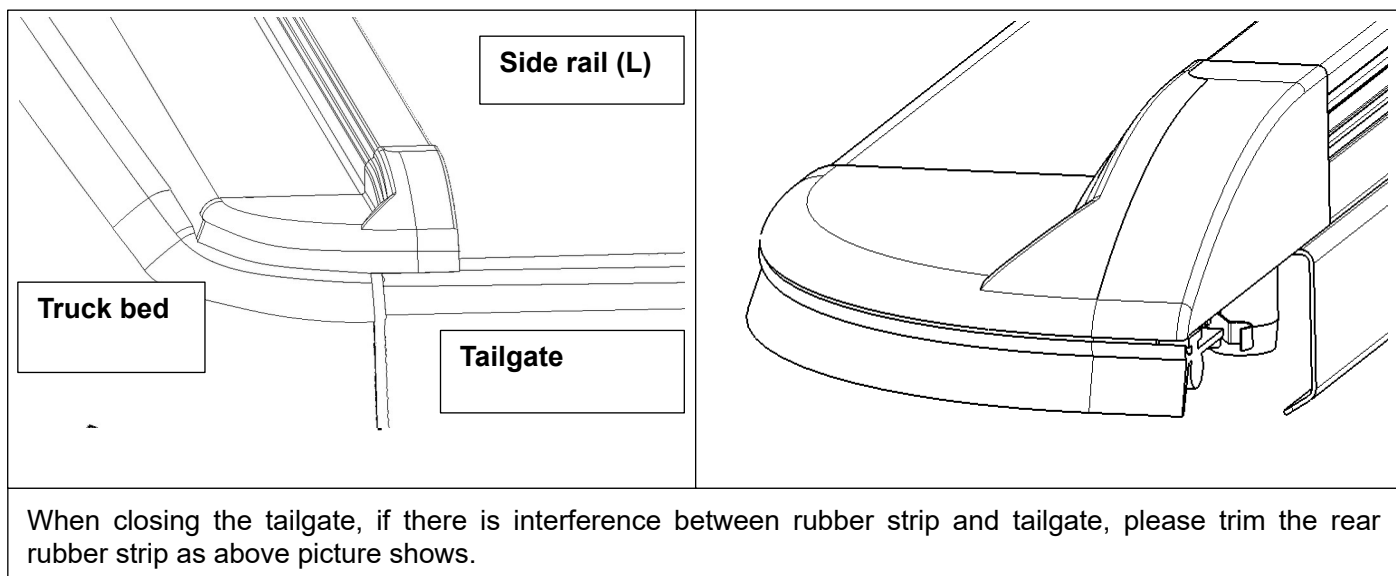
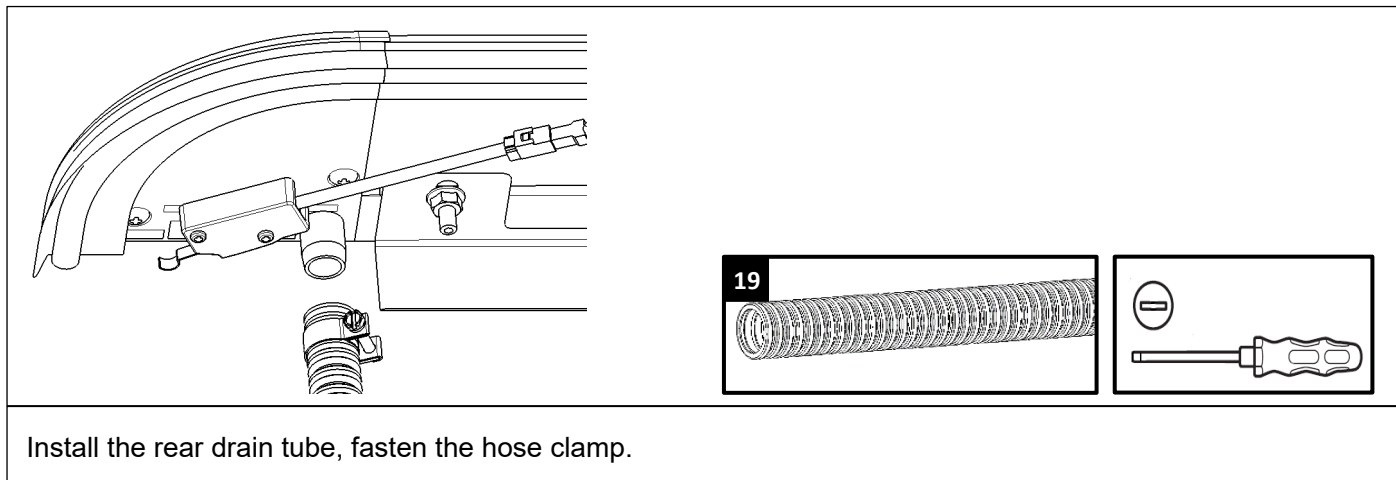
Put on the cover plate, adjust it to appropriate position.

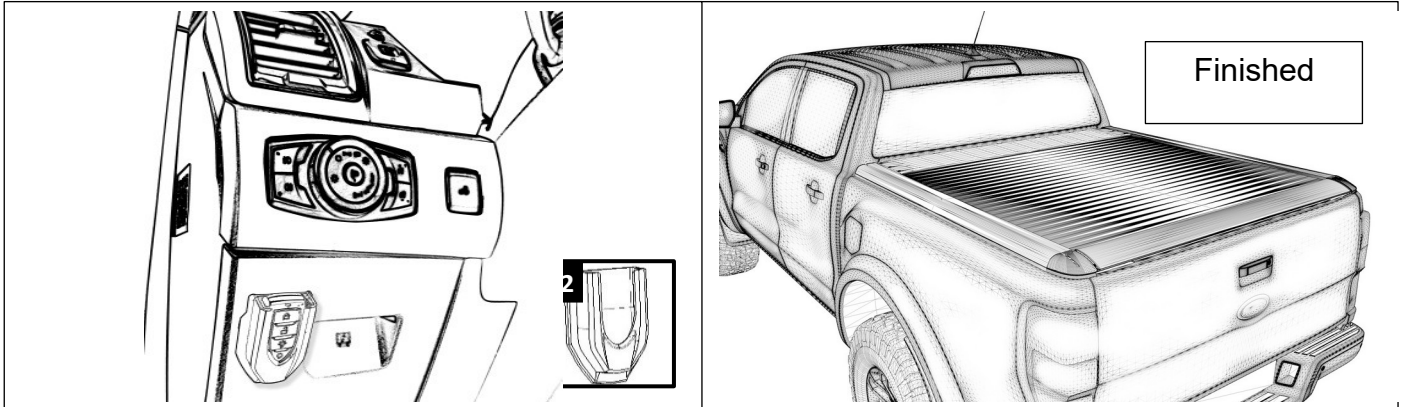


Install the top plate, fasten it with plastic base and M5_6 inner hex bolt. Then put on the plastic cover.



Put the rubber washer on the front drain tube (the threaded side), then install the drain tube on canister. Thread the front drain tube to the truck bed, fasten the hose clamp.





For convenience, maybe you can keep one of the remote control in driver cabin.

(Such as sticking the key holder on below of the console, then put the remote control in it)
