





INSTALLATION PROCEDURE




STEP 1:

Remove the Radiator Grille, Grille Infill Panel, Wheel Arch Flares and Bumper Fascia from the vehicle. (refer to Mitsubishi workshop manual for instructions)

If Fog Lamps are fitted, carefully disconnect the Fog Lamp Harness from the Fog Lamps before removing the Bumper Fascia.

STEP 2:

Remove the Lower Grille and the Air Guides from the Bumper Fascia.

Keep the Air Guides for reattachment. (refer Mitsubishi workshop manual for instructions)

STEP 3:


Working on the back surface of the Grille, use the provided template (on page 9 of this Instruction) to mark the centre position of the (4) Diameter 12mm holes with a suitable scribe or similar.

Drill the holes using a 12mm drill bit.

Carefully cut and file the opening ensuring a neat appearance using the dashed line of the template as a guide.

Refer Figure 3b (next page) for final trim appearance.



STEP 3: continued

This cutting is visible after Nudge Bar fitment. Carefully file or sand any sharp edges smooth for a neat appearance at the final installation.

STEP 4:

Using trimmers neatly remove the small section of the Air Guides to provide Nudge Bar mounting Brkt clearance.

File any sharp edges smooth for a neat appearance.




STEP 5:


Reattach the reworked Air Guides to the reworked Grille Lower, then reinstall the Grille Lower and Air Guide assy to the Bumper Fascia.



STEP 6:

Remove the Fog Lamp Splash Shields from the vehicle.


STEP 7:

On the Fog Lamp Splash Shields, mark a line parallel with the vertical face approx 65mm from the inner edge.

Using tin snips or similar, cut the Splash Shields to provide Nudge Bar mounting brkt clearance.

Discard the loose segments. Reattach the Splash Shield to the vehicle.



STEP 8:

Secure the LHS Mounting Brkt to the vehicle Chassis with: M10 Bolts (Item E - PA119) x 2 M10 Washers (Item H - PA221 x 1, Item J - PA222 x 2) M10 Nuts (Item G - PA181) x 2 M8 Bolt (Item F - PA160) x 1 M8 Washer (Item K - PA239) x 1 & M8 Nut Plate (Item D - MZ350415-300) x 1

Repeat for RHS Mounting Brkt.



ITEM E - M10 x 25 x 1.25P - TIGHTENING TORQUE = 44 +/- 2Nm



ITEM F - M8 x 25 x 1.25P - TIGHTENING TORQUE = 22 +/- 2Nm

STEP 9:

Secure the Bumper Fascia back on to vehicle, taking care to guide the Nudge Bar Mounting Brkts through the clearance holes in the Grille Lower.

If fitted, reconnect the Fog Lamp Harness to the Fog Lamps.

Re-fit the Radiator Grille and Grille Infill Panel removed at Step 1.





STEP 10:

Offer the Nudge Bar to the Mounting Brkts and secure with the M10 Bolts (Item E - PA119), M10 Washers (Item J - PA222) & M10 Nuts (Item G - PA181)

Note: the Stainless Steel Brkt is located outboard of the Painted Steel Brkts.



STEP 11:

Ensure the Nudge Bar is correctly aligned vertically and horizontally.

Using a Torque Wrench tighten all Bolts to the correct specification.



ITEM E - M10 x 25 x 1.25P - TIGHTENING TORQUE = 44 +/- 2Nm



STEP 12:

Re-fit the Wheel Arch Flares.





STEP 13:

Fit the Licence Plate to the Tabs provided and secure with: M5 Pozidriv Screws (Item L - PA169) x 2 M5 Washers (Item M - PJ790) x 4 M5 Spring Washers (Item N - PA224) x 2 & M5 Nuts (Item P - PJ789) x 2.

Using a Torque Wrench tighten all Fasteners to the correct specification.



ITEM L - M5 x 16 x 0.8P - TIGHTENING TORQUE = 3 + /- 0.5Nm

CARE AND HANDLING

- Do Not remove the compliance plate or label from the product
- This product has a polished stainless steel finish and has no protective coating, therefore, it's luster will reduce as time passes. To maintain the luster:
 - 1. Apply "3M Finesse-it" or "3M stainless Steel and polish" or equivalent metal polishing agent onto a clean cloth.
 - 2. Gently rub over the affected area like polishing the vehicle's paint surface.
 - 3. Buff off using clean cloth.
- 4. Repeat the above process if required.
